**Comments: All 11 dogs were feral -- 5 puppies & 6 adult dogs.**

Through our stray and feral cat program the Humane Society lend traps or help in trapping, pays for surgery and rabies and FVR shots. By giving people this alternative we help them choose not to call Animal Control or transport strays to the pound. In essence, we ask them to "adopt" rather than to dispose of the cats that have come to them for help.
